ACCESS TO GC3F IS (still) RESTRICTED!

Updated access rules for Recovery Stage 1:

RULE #1:

ALL USERS MUST WEAR PPE & DISINFECT ALL SURFACES:

- Wear a face mask & gloves at all times (labcoat is optional).
- Disinfect instruments & all contacted surfaces (including door knobs, freezer handles, light switches) with 70% EtOH, BOTH **BEFORE & AFTER USE,** per instructions on each instrument.
- Maintain ≥6 ft from others, including during sample dropoff.

RULE #2: MAX OF 3 USERS (plus 2 staff) are permitted at any time.

- The iLab "Facility Access" calendar is no longer required. Yay!
- We have added 3 OCCUPANCY SIGNS on our door.
 - ✓ When you ENTER, switch a sign to OCCUPIED.
 - ✓ When you **LEAVE**, switch a sign to **VACANT** (and disinfect sign).
- If all signs show OCCUPIED, you must wait until someone leaves!
- **RULE #3:**
- For **INSTRUMENTS THAT REQUIRE RESERVATION** (qPCR, plate reader, etc.), you must STILL reserve time on that iLab calendar.
- RULE #4:
- Access is only permitted to **FULLY TRAINED STAFF** (e.g. graduate students, postdocs, staff scientists). New users are not permitted.
- **RULE #5:**
- Prior to entering GC3F, all users must **TAKE THEIR BODY TEMP** (on the same day) and not enter GC3F if their temperature is elevated or if they have any other symptoms of COVID-19.
- RULE #6:
- **DO NOT PROP OPEN THE GC3F DOORS** at any time. Users must swipe their access card each time they enter, and GC3F will verify card the access logs against the Facility Access calendar in iLab.
- RULE #7:
- Please report any **RULE VIOLATIONS** to genomics@uoregon.edu!!! Rule violations may result in revoking your GC3F card access.
